

Francisco Antonio Macías Domínguez

In 1979 he obtained a degree from the University of Seville and in 1984 the degree of Doctor from the University of Cádiz. In 1986 he became Titular Professor of University, and in 2000 University Professor, position that he currently occupies. During his career he has held various management positions, such as: Director of the International Relations Secretariat, Director of the Department of Organic Chemistry, Dean of the Faculty of Sciences, Vice-Rector for Research and currently Director of the Institute of Biomolecules (INBIO) of the University of Cádiz since 2014.

His scientific contribution ascends to 277 publications (226 articles, 51 book chapters and 2 books) and more than 345 contributions to congresses. He has participated in 40 projects / research contracts (2 European, 25 national and 13 regional), of which 11 patents have been generated as result. He has directed 30 Doctoral Theses, and currently he is directing 5.
